## LONG SERVICE AWARDS

## OFFERED IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2011 SUFFOLK SHOW

ENTRIES CLOSE: **16 March 2011** (No Entry Fee)

Class	<u>Employed by a Vice President or Member of the Suffolk Agricultural Association</u>	Framed Certificates
1)	To a person who has worked on the same farm, or with the same employer on their farm, for at least <b>thirty complete years</b> .	Up to 20 Certificates Awarded
2)	To a person who has <b>completed fifty years</b> service on the same farm or with the same employer on their farm. (Employees who have already received a 30 years certificate can be entered for this award)	Special Certificate
3)	To a person who has <b>completed sixty years</b> service on the same farm or with the same employer on their farm. (Employees who have already received a fifty years certificate <b>can</b> be entered for this award)	Special Certificate
4)	Special Open Award for outstanding Services to Agriculture in Suffolk. A Maximum of 4 Special awards will be made for outstanding service to Agriculture in Suffolk. <b>Written nominations to the Executive Director should be both proposed and seconded by either Vice Presidents or Members of the Suffolk Agricultural Association.</b>	Special Certificate

Award winners in all classes receive a special certificate and have the right each year to apply in writing for two free Member's Badges and a car pass.

Award winners will be notified by post following the April Council Meeting and the presentations will be made during the Show, for which an admission ticket covering the recipient and one other, will be forwarded. All Award winners and their partners will be invited to lunch on that day as guests of the Association. A full list of Award recipients and their employers will be published in the Show Catalogue.

**Candidates must be recommended by and work for a member in the capacity described.** Duty in the Armed Services to be included in length of service provided the employee returned to the same farm or premises or with the same employer. No Award will be made to any candidate for long service who has not worked at least thirty complete years for Class 1, fifty complete years for Class 2 and sixty complete years for Class 3. Nominations in writing can be made for Special Awards for Services to Agriculture. Persons gaining Awards will not be eligible to enter in the same class another year.

The Council has the power to withhold any Award or number of Awards.
