The Veronica Jolly Perpetual Challenge Trophy - for the exhibitor gaining most points in classes 2-9

The "Diana Alexander" Salver - for the Best Exhibit in Class 1 (Flower Clubs)

The Perpetual Challenge Salver presented by Mrs Myrtle Ratliff - for the Best Exhibit in Class 11 (Novice)

The Margaret Burton Perpetual Trophy - for the Best Use of Fresh Garden Plant Material in Classes 2-12, *except Class 10*

The Rosemary Black Perpetual Trophy - for the Best Use of Colour in Classes 2-12, *except Class 10*

### REGULATIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- 1) All entries are classed as exhibits and judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual (Second Edition 2009), **copies may be obtained from NAFAS Enterprises Limited (Trading) Osborne House 12 Devonshire Square London EC2M 4TE (Price £5.00 + large sae).**
- 2) The Judges' decision shall be final.
- 3) All exhibits and exhibitors' property will be at the risk of the exhibitor and the Suffolk Agricultural Association accepts NO liability whatsoever for any loss or damage sustained by any exhibitor.
- 4) Exhibits must be the unaided work of the exhibitor and must be arranged in the marquee, (with the exception of Classes 10,13 and 14 which may be brought ready assembled), between 12 noon and 8.30pm on Wednesday 6 June 2012. Individual exhibitors will NOT be admitted to the marquee until 12 noon. However, exhibitors in Class 1 (Clubs) will be admitted at 11.30am to ease congestion.
- 5) *Exhibits must remain on view until 6.00pm on Friday 8 June 2012*
- 6) Please note that on staging day **Wednesday 6 June 2012** there will be no food and drink available on the showground – please provide your own.
- 7) At least seven days before the Show, confirmation of entries will be sent with a two-day Exhibitor's Badge, which must be worn whilst staging and during the Show, and a car pass which must be displayed on the windscreen at all times. Exhibitors' cars will be allowed onto the Showground via Gate 6 (Bucklesham Road) on Wednesday 6 June 2012 for staging and on Friday 8 June 2012, between 4.00pm and 6.00pm, for collection of exhibits.
- 8) No perishable foods, with the exception of fresh fruit and vegetables, to be used in exhibits.
- 9) Mechanics, drapes, backgrounds etc MUST NOT be attached to the staging.
- 10) Aerosol spray cans or paint or other finishes MUST NOT be used in the marquee.
- 11) After judging, no exhibit may be touched by any exhibitor. During the Show, all exhibits will be in the care of the stewards who reserve the right to remove and/or replace any wilted plant material at their discretion.
- 12) Premiums and prize money will be posted to exhibitors after the Show.
- 13) Please help the stewards look after your exhibits by not completely filling containers with foam and leaving adequate space for water. Foam dries out quickly in marquee conditions and fresh plant material wilts rapidly, exhibitors are therefore advised to ensure that all fresh plant materials are in water or foam.
- 14) Please make every effort to stage exhibits for all classes entered as marquee space is costly; blank spaces spoil the overall effect of the Show and are disappointing for the visiting public.
- 15) The Association reserves the right to restrict the number of entries in any Class. It is therefore advisable to send entries early to avoid disappointment.
- 16) If there are five or less entries in any class the Association reserves the right to reduce the number of prizes awarded or withdraw the class, as deemed necessary.
- 17) ENTRIES CLOSE at 12 noon on FRIDAY 20<sup>TH</sup> APRIL 2012. Please enclose a stamped addressed envelope for acknowledgment of receipt.

# CELEBRATORY YEAR

## CLASS 1: THE OLYMPIC GAMES

An exhibit depicting a competing country. Country to be named. To be staged by no more than three members of a club. Space allowed 140cm wide, 140cm deep, height optional. Staged on a mahogany base 122cm square, 20cm high. Base must be placed centrally within the space allowed and may be covered by exhibitors.  
**To be viewed and judged all round. A premium of £85 is offered for every entry staged.**

**PRIZES: £35, £25, £20, £17.**

## CLASS 2: GOD SAVE THE QUEEN

A pedestal exhibit. Space allowed 140cm wide, 140cm deep, height optional. Staged on a circular base provided 122cm diameter raised 5cm from the ground. Base to be covered by the exhibitor. Background cream marquee lining.

**PRIZES: £30, £25, £20, £17.**

## CLASS 3: SIXTY GLORIOUS YEARS

An exhibit depicting an event during the Queen's reign. May be staged by one or two exhibitors. Space allowed 105cm wide, 100cm deep, 244cm high. To be staged on a brown painted base 91cm wide, 93cm deep and 30cm high. Background dove grey fabric.

**PRIZES: £25, £20, £18, £15.**

## CLASS 4: A ROYAL RESIDENCE

An exhibit. Title to be included. Space allowed 75cm wide, 70cm deep, 120cm high. Background dove grey fabric.

**PRIZES: £18, £15, £12, £10.**

## CLASS 5: TROOPING THE COLOUR

An exhibit. Space allowed 75cm wide, 70 deep, 120cm high. Background dove grey.

**PRIZES: £20, £16, £14, £12.**

## CLASS 6: POWER AND STRENGTH

A exhibit featuring foliage. Space allowed 50cm wide, 70cm deep, height optional. Background cream marquee lining.

**PRIZES: £18, £15, £12, £10.**

## CLASS 7: BACK TO THE FIFTIES

A Period exhibit. Space allowed 75cm wide, 70cm deep, 120cm high. Background dove grey fabric.

**PRIZES: £20, £16, £14, £12.**

## CLASS 8: SYNCHRONISE

An exhibit. Space allowed 75cm wide, 70cm deep, height optional. Background cream marquee lining.

**PRIZES: £18, £15, £12, £10.**

## CLASS 9: GOING FOR GOLD

A petite exhibit. Space allowed 25cm wide, 25cm deep, 25cm high. Staging and tabling covered in dove grey fabric.

**PRIZES: £15, £12, £10, £8.**

## CLASS 10: CIRCLES AND DIAMONDS

A craft exhibit. A plaque featuring dried / preserved plant material. Space allowed 80cm wide, 20cm deep. Hanging wire to be provided by exhibitor. Background wood painted dark grey.

**PRIZES: £15, £12, £10, £8.**

## RESTRICTED CLASSES

### CLASS 11: ON YOUR MARKS

An exhibit depicting a sport. Space allowed 70cm wide, 70cm deep, height optional. Background cream marquee cream.

**This class is open to NOVICES only (those who have never won a FIRST prize at any Suffolk Show).**

**PRIZES: £18, £15, £12, £10.**

### CLASS 12: STREET PARTY

An exhibit. Space allowed 70cm wide, 70cm deep, 120cm high. Background dove grey.

**This class is open to any Suffolk Young Farmers' Club member.**

**PRIZES: £18, £15, £12, £10.**

### CLASS 13: KICK OFF (11 years & under)

A craft exhibit featuring dried / preserved plant material. A 12cm foam sphere to be used with a 5cm wire loop for hanging attached. Space allowed 25cm wide, 25cm deep, 25cm high. Background wood painted dark grey.

**This class is open to JUNIORS only, aged 11 years and under on 1 June 2012.**

**PRIZES: £14, £10, £8, £6.**

### CLASS 14: KICK OFF (12-17 years)

A craft exhibit featuring dried / preserved plant material. A 12cm foam sphere to be used with a 5cm wire loop for hanging attached. Space allowed 25cm wide, 25cm deep, 25cm high. Background wood painted dark grey.

**This class is open to JUNIORS only, aged 12-17 years on 1 June 2012.**

**PRIZES: £14, £10, £8, £6.**

**IMPORTANT, PLEASE NOTE:** Depending on the number and age of entrants in classes 13 and 14, the age split between the two classes may be changed slightly to ensure an even distribution of entries.

**NOTE:** Classes 1-3 are staged on bases, placed directly on the ground.  
Classes 4 to 8, 11 & 12 to be staged on tabling approx. 75cm high, covered DOVE GREY  
All measurements are approximate.
